Samba is Free Software licensed under the [GNU General Public License](#), the Samba project is a member of the [Software Freedom Conservancy](#).

Since 1992, Samba has provided secure, stable and fast file and print services for all clients using the SMB/CIFS protocol, such as all versions of DOS and Windows, OS/2, Linux and many others.

Samba is an important component to seamlessly integrate Linux/Unix Servers and Desktops into Active Directory environments using the winbind daemon.

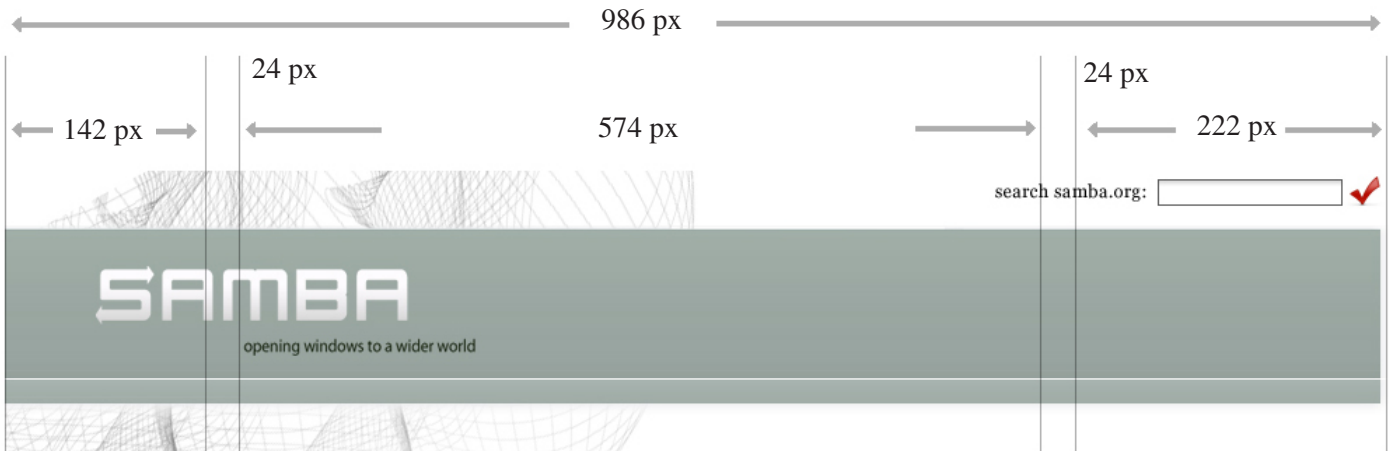

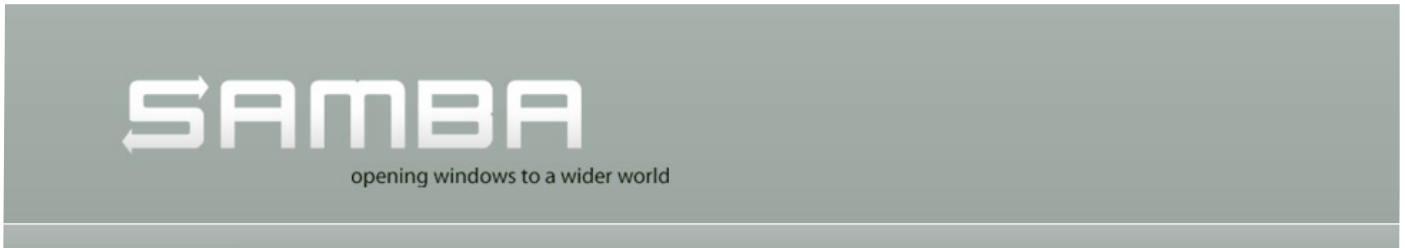
